

FULLY VACCINATED

Fully vaccinated people can resume activities without wearing a face covering over nose and mouth or physically distancing.

(People are considered fully vaccinated two weeks after the final dose of the COVID-19 vaccine.)

EXCEPTIONS: Federal, State or local laws, rules and regulations, including local business and workplace guidance may require fully vaccinated people to wear masks and/or physically distance.

UNVACCINATED

Unvaccinated people are not required to wear face coverings over nose and mouth when they are in outdoor public spaces, provided sustained or prolonged close contact with other unvaccinated people from outside their own household can be avoided.

Unvaccinated people are required to wear masks or facial coverings in public indoor spaces.

“Sustained or prolonged contact” is defined as more than several minutes.

“Close contact” is defined as being less than six feet from an individual from outside your household.
